



**INTERNATIONAL

HOST FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES**

GENERAL TRANSPORTATION RESPONSIBILITIES

- If you are assigned to the arrival dates (May 25 – May 30, 2012), you will be provided with the travel itinerary for the international camp staff. The Host Family is responsible for retrieving the international camp staff from the airport when she arrives.
- If you are assigned to the departure dates (July 29-August 1, 2012), you will be provided with the travel itinerary for the international camp staff. The Host Family is responsible for taking the international camp staff to the airport in time to board her departing flight.
- For all assigned dates, the Host Family is responsible for picking up the international camp staff on the last day of the session:
 - by 7:00 p.m. from Camp Tallchief (Skiatook)
 - or -
 - by 8:00 p.m. from the Girl Scout Service Center (Tulsa)
- For all assigned dates, the Host Family is responsible for dropping off the international camp staff on the first day of the session:
 - by 2:00 p.m. at Camp Tallchief (Skiatook)
 - or -
 - by 1:00 p.m. at the Girl Scout Service Center (Tulsa)

GENERAL ROOM AND BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES

Applies to all assigned dates

- The Host Family is responsible for providing the international camp staff with the basic human needs: food, water, and shelter.
- The Host Family is responsible for ensuring that the international camp staff has access to bathing/toilet facilities and a place to sleep.
- The Host Family is responsible for providing transportation for the international camp staff to and from camp for work.
- The Host Family is responsible for providing the international camp staff with reasonable amounts of food and drink. This includes all traditional meals that your family is accustomed to taking.
